<p>North Lincolnshire Councillors Report</p> <p>The following information was given:</p> <p>Cllr Ogg reported that a site visit had taken place at the landfill site and that planning application would be submitted in due course.</p> <p>It was noted that the Local Authority had granted Alkborough Primary School £80,000 for capital works.</p> <p>Cllr Ogg informed the Council that he had spoken to North Lincolnshire Council about the 'no horse riding signs' which had been erected on private land. Cllr Ogg confirmed that these signs had now been taken down as the landowner had given permission for horse riders to use the land.</p>

<p>The Councillors agreed that these invoices should be paid and the cheques were duly signed.</p> <p>Cllr Dent reported that he had been given a letter from North Lincolnshire</p>		

<p>Council addressed to West Halton Cemetery. The letter contained a demand notice for arrears of rates from the previous financial year. Cllr Marper agreed to take this back to the Council and query whether the £65 late payment fee could be waived.</p> <p>The Clerk asked whether the Council would be happy to renew the SLA for grass cutting this year. It was proposed that the Clerk contact North Lincolnshire Council and ask whether the hedge in the cemetery could be cut twice a year as part of the cost.</p> <p>Annual Return - The Clerk talked through the closing balances to date for the budget 2015/16. It was noted that the Council had not yet paid legal fees for the renewal of the lease.</p>	
<p>Highway Matters</p> <p>Holes in Road Surfaces:</p> <p>It was agreed again that the Local Authority be contacted about Winteringham Lane as the roads are still full of mud, the verge needs addressing, and the kerb is diminishing. Clerk to contact Highways again and ask them to revisit the lane.</p> <p>Pot holes were reported on the following roads:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Church side near the church ➤ Outside North View on Winteringham Lane ➤ West Street <p>Cllr Batley reported that he still had not had a response from Colas regarding his complaint over chipped window screens. Cllr Batley raised concern over the surface still breaking off at the junction. Cllr Ogg agreed to report back to North Lincolnshire Council.</p> <p>Cllr Robinson reported that the footpath on Coleby Road retains the water when it is raining and therefore residents are unable to walk along it easily in bad weather.</p>	<p>Clerk</p> <p>Clerk</p>

<p>Planning</p> <p>Planning Permission Requested: PA/2016/332 – Planning permission to vary conditions 4, 6, 10, 11, 20 of WD/2003/1842 to extend life of landfill site to 2026, revise landfill phasing, final landform and restoration. It was noted that on the map there is a wind turbine which should not be on the map.</p> <p>Planning Permission Granted: PA/2016/276 - Full Planning Permission with conditions.</p>
