<p>The following information was given:</p> <p>Cllr Ogg suggested that Tim Allen from North Lincolnshire Council be contacted to ask about solar panels for Alkborough Primary, if the school were interested. It was agreed that the Clerk contact Tim and ask whether other charities or local community groups could express an interest in obtaining solar panels.</p> <p>It was noted that NLC are currently looking at developing a policy to ensure that IO6 conditions for community pay back are adhered to when planning applications are granted. Cllr Ogg to keep the Council informed.</p> <p>Cllr Ogg informed the Council that NLC Highways have revisited Coleby Road</p>	Clerk

on several occasions to sweep the road after it was recently resurfaced.

<p>Village Green</p> <p>a) St Eltheldreda’s Church Repair Project It was noted that Cllrs Robinson and Ferraby would attend the next project meeting which is due to take place on the 29th October.</p> <p>b) Play Equipment: It was noted that the Clerk had circulated draft policies needed to apply for funds to the Community Pot. The Councillors agreed that these policies be adopted.</p> <p>The Clerk noted that as part of the application for the Community Pot bid the Council would need to evidence their fund raising efforts. The Clerk asked whether this could be a joint project with the village hall as they are a registered charity and regularly organise fund raising events.</p> <p>The Clerk reported that a draft copy of the bid would be circulated for Councillors to comment.</p> <p>Lease: Cllr Dent reported that Smiths Gore is progressing with the lease and that he will keep the Council up to date of any progress.</p> <p>c) Graveyard: It was noted that the graveyard was being cut by NLC Highways however the mound on the green was not cut. Cllr Ogg reported that this was due to health and safety reasons.</p>	
<p>Correspondence Received</p> <p>North Lincolnshire Council Forthcoming meetings - the information from NLC will be displayed.</p> <p>Street Works List – previously circulated via email to all Councillors.</p> <p>Winter Requirements – it was proposed that Councillors Batley and Hodson be designated snow wardens for the Council. It was agreed that the Council request the two tonnes of salt from NLC, Cllr Ogg offered to store the salt for the Council.</p> <p>Other Correspondence a) South Humber Bank Newsletter – this was previously circulated via email.</p>	
<p>Comments from Councillors to Chairman and Clerk</p> <p>Cllr Dent reported that he had spoken with Sean Brennan from the NLC broadband project who had advised that he contact Quickline Communications who are the provider for the project. Cllr Dent asked whether the Council would be happy for him to contact Quickline to address some of the issues the village face with internet connectivity and speed. The Council fully supported this.</p>
